

PRIVACY POLICY

At 3-102-947020 LLC, we are committed to safeguarding and preserving the privacy of our visitors. This Privacy Policy (**the “Policy”**) explains how we collect, use, and protect any personal data concerning you (**“Personal Data” or “Data”**) when you use the Website, purchase our digital services, or communicate with us via the Website or through the contact details provided on it. We may update this Policy from time to time, so we encourage you to review it periodically.

By providing your Personal Data, you acknowledge and consent to our processing of that information in accordance with this Policy and applicable laws. If you do not agree to these terms, please refrain from using this Website. You may access and browse our Website without providing any Personal Data.

DEFINITIONS

Personal Data – any information relating to an identifiable individual.

Processing – any operation performed on Personal Data (collection, storage, use, disclosure, deletion).

Data Subject – the individual whose Personal Data is processed.

Service Providers – third parties who process data on our behalf.

USAGE OF YOUR DATA

We process your Personal Data only where we have a lawful basis to do so. This may include situations where processing is necessary to perform a contract with you, to comply with legal obligations, to pursue our legitimate interests (or those of a third party) where your rights do not override those interests, to protect your vital interests or those of others, or where processing is in the public interest.

We use your Personal Data only for the purposes for which it was originally collected. If we determine that it is necessary to use your Data for a compatible purpose, we will inform you and explain the legal basis for doing so.

DATA COLLECTION

We use analytics services provided by **Google LLC** through **Google Analytics**. These services collect information such as the total time you spend on the Website, the time spent on each page, the sequence of pages visited, the internal links you click. We use only

technically necessary cookies required for the operation of the Website. These cookies do not require your consent and cannot be disabled without affecting core Website functionality.

Technical Data

We automatically collect certain technical information, including your IP address, system configuration details, and other traffic-related data concerning your interaction with the Website.

Contact Data

When you contact us via the Website interface or email, you provide your name, email address, the subject of your inquiry, and the content of your message together with any information it contains.

Order Data

When you order digital services through the Website, you provide, in addition to Contact Data, information related to your order.

Payment Data

When making payments for services via the Website, you provide transaction details necessary to identify and process the payment.

Verification Data

In certain cases, you may be required to complete a verification process in accordance with applicable laws, including anti-money laundering regulations and for the prevention of fraud and abuse. This may include proof of identity such as a passport, government-issued ID, or driver's license, proof of ownership of your payment instrument in the form of a photo of the card with sensitive numbers and CVV concealed while the cardholder's name and expiry date remain visible, a photo of you holding your identification document and payment instrument, as well as proof of address such as a utility bill or similar document. In some cases, a selfie with this document may also be required. Where this process involves identity documents or equivalent sensitive data, we will request your explicit consent separately prior to collection (GDPR Art. 6(1)(a)).

Your information, whether public or private, will not be sold, exchanged, transferred, or provided to any third party without your consent, except where necessary for the purpose of delivering the services you have purchased.

STORING THE DATA

In addition to the circumstances described elsewhere in this Policy, we may share your Personal Data with third-party service providers. These parties are required to protect your

Personal Data and process it in accordance with applicable laws. We do not sell your Personal Data to third parties.

We may share your Personal Data where required by law, where necessary to enforce our agreements, to protect our rights, property, or safety, or where there is a legitimate interest in doing so, including fraud prevention and risk reduction.

We may also share your Data with contractors, agents, and service providers who support the delivery of our services for operational, administrative, reporting, system maintenance, and business restructuring purposes.

In certain situations, such as a business sale, restructuring, or where required by regulators or law enforcement authorities, we may also disclose your Personal Data.

The transmission of information over the internet is not completely secure and may, on occasion, be intercepted. We cannot guarantee the security of Data transmitted to us electronically, and any such transmission is at your own risk. Once we receive your Data, we implement appropriate technical and organizational measures to safeguard and store it securely.

THIRD-PARTY WEBSITES

Our Website may include links or hyperlinks to websites owned and operated by third parties. Accessing such websites is at your own risk. We do not control and are not responsible for the content, policies, or practices of any third-party websites, nor for any consequences arising from your use of them. We recommend reviewing the privacy policies of those websites before providing any personal information.

DATA RETENTION

We retain Personal Data only for as long as necessary to fulfill the purposes for which it was collected, including to satisfy legal, accounting, or reporting requirements. The retention period depends on the nature, sensitivity, and purpose of the Data, as well as the legal requirements applicable to us.

In some cases, we may anonymize your Personal Data so that it can no longer be associated with you. Such anonymized Data may be used without further notice.

YOUR RIGHTS

Under data protection laws, you have certain rights regarding your Personal Data. You have the right to receive clear information about how your Data is used, to request access to your Data, to request correction of inaccurate Data, to request deletion of your Data where there is no lawful reason to retain it, to object to processing based on legitimate interests or for direct

marketing purposes, to request restriction of processing, to request transfer of your Data to another party, and to withdraw your consent where processing is based on consent.

You also have the right to lodge a complaint with your national data protection authority if you believe your Data is being processed unlawfully.

You are not required to pay a fee to exercise your rights unless your request is manifestly unfounded or excessive, in which case we may charge a reasonable fee or refuse to comply. To process your request, we may ask you to provide additional information to verify your identity as a security measure.
